

SOUTHSIDE ESTATES TRAFFIC CALMING

Per the request of Southside Estates Civic Association, City of Jacksonville Traffic Engineering performed a traffic calming study along the corridors of Peach Drive, Forest Boulevard and Live Oak Drive between Beach Boulevard and Atlantic Boulevard. Crash analyses and spot speed studies were conducted to investigate existing traffic conditions. The study concluded the need for installation of traffic calming devices. The results of the study and traffic calming concepts of speed tables and mini roundabouts were presented to the requestors on July 8, 2019 at the Southside Estates Civic Association meeting, in presence of CM Wilson. The concept of speed tables was voted on by the attendees.

During the meeting, a request was made to add Forest Boulevard between Peach Drive and Beach Boulevard for speed tables.

Study Recommendations:

- Install approximately 35 speed tables (22 along Peach Drive – Forest Boulevard – Live Oak Drive; 13 along Forest boulevard extension) – See attached for approximate locations of speed tables
Cost for installation of 35 speed tables is estimated as \$211,575.
